

# Local support, supporting locals

**Since 1968**, Lifeline Northern Beaches has worked to prevent suicide and support mental health in our own backyard.

This year we celebrated a milestone **55 years** of impact in our community, including **30 years** providing companionship to aged care residents. To date we have answered **over 1,000,000** crisis calls, and helped reduce the drivers of distress via thousands of counselling sessions.

Lifeline Northern Beaches funds all our community programs through partnerships, grants, retail, donations and fundraising efforts.



# **Our Vision** An Australia free of suicide

## **Our Purpose**

We create connection with people in crisis and empower individuals and communities to be safe from suicide.

Everything we do is directed at this purpose.

## Our National Problem

- Over 3,200 Australians die by suicide annually - up YOY
- Over 7 million Australian adults are close to someone who has died or has attempted suicide.
- Suicide is the **15th** leading cause of death in our country
- **1 in 2** young people are impacted by suicide by the time they turn 25
- Suicide is the **leading cause of death** for Australian youth aged 15 -24
- Males are 3 x more likely to die by suicide than females

## Our Community Problem

- **42%**\* of Domestic Violence assaults in the Northern Beaches involved alcohol
- Domestic assault incidents up 21.8%\* (April 22-March 24 – 2-year trend)
- **40**<sup>^</sup> suicides p.a.
- 185<sup>^</sup> self-harm hospital admissions
- High incidence of mental health related hospitalisation (41%<sup>^</sup> higher than NSW)
- High risk drinking rate for 18+ (31%<sup>></sup> higher than NSW)


